**GENERAL INFORMATION**

1. Transferring to the CSU system consists of reaching junior status by completing 60 transferable units with a minimum 2.0 GPA, including major requirements, general education, and/or electives. A maximum of 70 CSU-transferable units are applied to the bachelor's degree after transfer.
2. To be eligible to transfer to a CSU, students must complete Areas A1, A2, A3, and B4 with a grade of C or higher in each course.
3. CSU general education certification requires completion of all requirements in Areas A through E, approximately 39 units.
4. A course can be used only once to fulfill an Area A through E requirement.
5. Students whose majors require more than 30 units are encouraged to meet with a counselor regarding the advisability of completing all major requirements instead of all general education requirements.
