- LD Core for major must be completed with a "C" or better and prior to enrolling in Upper Division (UD) Core.

FOOTNOTES: PLEASE READ

- Prerequisites strictly enforced. Grade of "C-" or better is required in prerequisite course.
- Students can opt to take PHIL 3560 Professional Business Ethics.
- Satisfies GE UD Area C4. Area C (C1, C2, C3, C4) must be completed with courses from at least three different disciplines.
- Students planning to complete all requirements (GE, major, graduation) in sixth term should apply for graduation on MyCSUEB.
- Students can opt to take MGMT 4500 Business, Government and Society or ACCT 4223 Business Law for Accountants, but are encouraged to take ACCT 4911. If ACCT 4223 or 4911 are taken for the UD Core, they cannot be used as Accounting option electives.
- Satisfies GE UD Area D4. Area D (D1, D2, D3, D4) must be completed with courses from at least three different disciplines.
- Students can opt to take ECON 3107 Global Economic Analysis.
- Students must choose from the approved list of Accounting option electives. Students interested in the following paths are suggested to take the listed courses as electives. **Internal Audit:** ACCT 4252, 4253. **Taxation:** ACCT 4220, 4221. **CPA Exam:** ACCT 3170, 3230, 3280, 4211, 4220. Please see reverse side for a full list of Accounting option electives and course titles.
- Prerequisite courses must be completed at least the quarter prior to taking MGMT 4650. Students must have applied for graduation for the same quarter that they plan to take MGMT 4650.
