Doctoral degree preferred, but Master's degree acceptable. Candidates must have relevant professional experience and possess an administrative services credential.

In addition, candidates must have: a) current knowledge of the content they teach/supervise; b) knowledge of the current context of public schooling including the California adopted P-12 content standards, frameworks, and accountability system; c) knowledge of diversity in society, including diverse abilities, culture, language, ethnicity, and gender orientation; and d) demonstration of effective professional practices in teaching and learning, scholarship, and service.

Courses may take place in local school districts, at the Hayward or Concord Campuses or as fully on-line courses. Courses are typically offered evenings.
