NEW STANDARDS

Includes

- Social Emotional Learning
- Restorative Practices
- Arts Integration
- UDL and emphasis on SPED

NEW COURSES

- Single Subject More time in methods courses.
- SS/MS SPED and EL spread out over the year.
- Aligned to new standards and edTPA.
- Field work seminar.
- Summer course still intern compliant.
- Focus on integrating course/field work.

SEMESTERS

- Classes begin June 18 (Summer Quarter)
- Fall Semester begins Aug 20
- Field work begins at the same time.
- Spring Semester begins January 22, 2019
- Classes end May 18, 2019
- (Full semester program begins summer 2019)

FIELD WORK

- Begins August.
- First placement (MS/SS): 3 hours a day, 5 days a week, 2 week solo teaching, ends around December 16.
- Second placement (MS/SS): 5 hours a day, 5 days a week. Begins Jan 22. Ends May 18. 2 week solo teaching.
- 600+ hours total.
- 12 supervisor visits.

NEW PROGRAM STANDARDS COOPERATING TEACHERS

- Cooperating teachers need to receive 10 hours of training. (Cognitive Coaching, Adult Learning Theory, Current Pedagogy.)
- Supervision can be virtual.
- Improvement plan sent with candidates to Induction Program.
