**SUBJECT:** 12-13 CAPR 12: New Self-support certificate request for [Health Informatics Graduate Certificate](#) in the Department of Public Affairs and Administration

**ACTION REQUESTED:** For approval by the Academic Senate; effective Fall 2014

**BACKGROUND:**

At CAPR's February 7, 2013 meeting, Associate Dean Jiansheng Guo and Dr. Toni Fogarty presented the certificate request for a new self-support graduate certificate in Health Informatics. Kaiser has provided a letter of support for the certificate, and Dr. Fogarty hopes that it will lead to student scholarships in the future. The current plan is to offer the program as self-support online, but there is interest in a hybrid format as well. Currently, three experienced lecturers will be teaching the courses for the certificate. There are an estimated 30 students who will be seeking this certificate. Dr. Fogarty was commended for connecting and including SLOs and ILOs in the new certificate proposal.

CAPR passed this request unanimously and asks that the Academic Senate consider approving the Self-support certificate request for Health Informatics Graduate Certificate in the Department of Public Affairs and Administration.
