PURPOSE: Action by the Senate
ACTION REQUESTED: That the Academic Senate approves the discontinuance of the M.S. in Taxation program; effective Fall quarter 2014

BACKGROUND:

At its meeting on April 4, 2013, CAPR received a modification request to discontinue the M.S. in Taxation program. As explained in the supporting document, and by Associate Dean Xinjian Lu and Dr. Micah Frankel, there is a lack of full-time faculty for this program, and the program's current director is retiring. This program is entirely on-line and therefore its discontinuance is expected to have a minimal impact on other programs in the department and college.

ACTION REQUESTED:

CAPR voted unanimously to pass the discontinuance of this program, and requests that the Academic Senate approve the discontinuance of the program as requested; effective Fall quarter 2014.
