The program outlines its goals from the 2009 review. At its last five year review, the program had just proposed a set of curricular changes across three options. These changes went into effect six months after the five year review and have been successful. Administrative constraints have limited the expansion of the program with a new option in Animation/Game Design. The program is still considering this as an option. The program has converted Art History courses to online delivery and is in the process of conducting an assessment of these efforts. The program did not pursue its goal of creating an MFA program but instead proposed a merger with the Multimedia Graduate Program. That merger now provides the Art program with a masters degree and provides a platform to develop a MFA degree.

The program has seen an increase of students over the past five years and is at capacity for studio spaces and computer labs for students. The program struggles to provide enough classes to students for timely graduation. Currently, all the program faculty are senior with two in FERP. Half of the program faculty will have retired in the next five year period. The program has hired a new Assistant Professor in multimedia and is currently searching for one art historian to replace two current faculty. The program is catching up in equipment from previous shortfalls but find the refresh time for computer equipment is not appropriate for design laboratories. The program has lost three full-time staff positions and has adapted by reducing student services and eliminating faculty services.

The program has a very robust assessment process and focused on the SLO 1 – “Think creatively from the expression of an idea to the completion of a work of art” this year. BA and BFA were assessed in the same way. The program conducted video interviews of students discussing their ideas and process. These videos were viewed by faculty and rated by faculty on a survey. The department used the data to review the curriculum and instruction finding that students were performing well but having some difficulty in articulating their process. The process also emphasized the importance of departmental rubrics for some courses and highlighted stresses and opportunities in the assessment process. The program is exploring an assessment committee rather than one faculty member taking responsibility. The program hopes that Blackboard will make collection of materials simpler in the future.
