PURPOSE: For approval by the Academic Senate; effective Fall 2015

BACKGROUND:

At its meeting on December 5, 2013, CAPR considered a request by Saeid Motavalli, Chair of the Department of Engineering, and Michael Leung, Dean of the College of Science (CSCI) to establish a new academic unit in the College of Science to be called the School of Engineering. This proposal to create the School of Engineering is based on the need for name recognition in attracting students and potential new faculty. Additionally, the formation of the School of Engineering would create an organization structure required for accreditation in Construction Management, Computer Engineering and reaccreditation for Industrial Engineering.

Based on the case made at its meeting by Chair Motavalli and Dean Leung, and through written documentation provided by CCSI, CAPR voted as follows to recommend approval of this proposal to create the School of Engineering:
