BACKGROUND:

At its meeting on March 7, 2019, CAPR discussed the College of Business and Economics' request to add "Accounting Concentration" to the existing self-support BSBA Online Program.

At the March 7, 2019 meeting, CAPR approved this proposal with one member abstaining from a vote. Based on conversations and questions raised regarding the impact of self-support programs on state-side enrollment and FTEs, members of CAPR recommended that the College of Business and Economics track enrollment and graduation rates to be included in annual reports and five-year reviews to CAPR. These reports should reflect any potential impact on the decrease of enrollment and FTE in state-side programs in the College of Business and Economics.
