**BACKGROUND**

**INFORMATION:** At its meeting on December 7, 2006, CAPR reviewed the attached documents from the Department of Public Affairs and Administration, requesting discontinuance of the two program options. The document described the department's review of its program and the seven options it offers. It determined that students' needs and program resources would be best served by reducing their number of program options to five. All courses were retained and the courses in Public Finance Administration were moved into the Public Management Option and the Administration of the Metropolitan Region courses were moved into the Public Policy Development Option. There is no impact on resources, personnel or other programs.

The request has been approved by the department, College Dean and faculty Review Body. CAPR unanimously voted to approve this request.
