SUBJECT: Actions of the Academic Senate

At its meeting of April 6, 2004, the Academic Senate took the following actions:

Approved the following items:

- **03-04 CIC 12**, U.S. History and Government (State Code) Requirement, as presented
- **03-04 CIC 13**, Learning Outcomes for the Lifelong Understanding General Education Requirement, as amended by 1) deleting "Area E" from the heading, so that it reads "Learning Outcomes for Lifelong Understanding General Requirement." 2) Changing the boldface part of #1 to "to address a particular topic that focuses on lifelong understanding and development of humans as integrated physiological, social and psychological entities. Topics may include human behavior, sexuality, nutrition, health, stress, key relationships of humankind to the social and physical environment and implications of death and dying, as well as others." 3) Deleting #5 and 4) Replacing the words "Have demonstrated an ability" with "Be able" in #4.
- **03-04 CIC 14**, Application of HIST ~~3250~~ 3020 Modern Imperialism and Colonialism to GE Area C4 for the 1996-98, 1998-2004, and Transfer GE
- **03-04 FAC 6**, Changes to the Appointment and Review Document
- the Senate minutes of February 3, and February 17, 2004, with minor changes

Heard reports from Faculty Trustee Kathleen Kaiser and Statewide Senate Chair Robert Cherny and had the opportunity to ask questions of our visitors.

The chair noted that the change to CIC 12, which was proposed by Cassuto and defeated, will be placed on the next ExCom agenda.
