Congratulated Karina Garbesi, Geography & ES and COBRA Chair, on her appointment to the CSU Sustainability Advisory Subcommittee on Education and Research

Heard a report from the President regarding outreach efforts, searches, FTE numbers, Town Hall meetings, Prop 1D funds and congratulated him on the acquisition of additional one-time funds for classroom furniture and renovation. Faculty will be included in the decision process for selecting specific rooms and types of furniture.

Discussed and provided feedback regarding University Union Food Services (V.P. Redmond, David Baggins (Faculty rep to the UU Board), Jay Hayes (Aramark representative) and Monica Pacheco, Exec.Dir. of the Union). The Winter Quarter will bring more variety and availability of healthful food choices. Email Pacheco with further feedback.

Questions raised by Senators regarding the new building project and faculty offices were answered by Barbara Haber, AVP Facilities Planning & Op. The Student Services/Administration Building is beginning in Spring 07 and is expected to be completed in early 09. WA will be emptied in mid 09 for renovation/deconstruction; funds will be in the next bond cycle in 08-09. There is no plan yet for moving faculty, but grouping faculty (for a sense of community) is a goal. A space planning expert will be consulted.
