- Donna Wiley, ACIP Rep, regarding the Annual Report of the Academic Council on International Programs at CSUEB; faculty participation in and encouragement to students interested in the program is appreciated, and helps global awareness.
- Provost Mahoney noted that 35 tenure track searches have been signed/sealed for next year. The number of 08-09 searches will not be determined until after we have firmed information about the upcoming budget.
- The Chair read a CSU Senate Resolution commending Cal Caplan for his statewide service
- The Chair reported on the cooperative effort of unions, individuals and the CSU toward budget reform for education, especially for next year's CSU budget.
