- John Charles, who provided a Fall IT update/announcement regarding Google-hosting of Faculty/Staff Email, Virtual Computing Labs, and Remote Support
- President Qayoumi, who noted the Princeton Review voted CSUEB "Best in the West" for the 4<sup>th</sup> year; the Physical Master Plan was recently adopted by the BoT; the Rec & Wellness building is on schedule for Fall 2010 completion; the Student Svcs and Admin building is scheduled for completion early in the next calendar year; a parking garage and phase 4 housing will begin soon; Fall enrollment figures are up slightly from last year (our CA resident target will be reduced by 9.5% for next year); notices have been to Deans and advising centers regarding "Super Seniors" to help them find classes/graduate; and answered many questions from Senators regarding the effects and possible effects of the budget cuts.
