SUBJECT: Update to Roster of Regular Members of the University Faculty, Fall Quarter, 2013

Following is a list of the Regular Members of the University Faculty and a list of College and Department Faculties prepared by the Membership Committee of the University Faculty. Please read your specific department/division/ area and notify the Office of the Academic Senate if there are any deletions, additions, or other corrections to be made (ext. 5-3671).

The following excerpts from the Constitution should be helpful:

Article II, Section 2:

No person shall be a Regular Member of more than one Department. Every person is a Regular Member of a Department Faculty who:

- A. holds a full time, annual, academic appointment within the University; and
- B. is officially assigned to a teaching service area administered by the department; and
- C. holds academic rank of Instructor or higher.

Article III, Section 2:

No person shall be a Regular Member of more than one College. The Regular Members of a College Faculty are the Deans of the College; the Regular Members of the departments within the College; and every person who:

- A. holds a full time, annual, academic appointment within the University; and
- B. is officially assigned to a teaching service area administered by that College; and
- C. holds academic rank of Instructor or higher.

A person holding a lecturer's appointment is not eligible for Regular Membership of the College Faculty.

Article IV, Section 2:

The Regular Members of the University Faculty are the President, Vice Presidents, and academic Associate Vice Presidents; the Regular members of the College Faculties within the University; the Regular Members of the Division of Libraries and other individuals holding tenure in an academic department. FERP (Faculty Early Retirement Program) and PRTB (Partially Reduced Time Base) faculty are included during quarters when in active employment. In addition, those individuals who are Regular Members of the University Faculty according to Article IV, Section 2 of the Constitution as of March 1, 1989, shall retain such membership as long as they occupy their present positions with the University. The Office of the Academic Senate shall maintain a list of these individuals.

The Membership Committee of the University Faculty has determined the Regular Members of the Department Faculties, Regular Members of the College and Division Faculties and Regular Members of the University Faculty, effective Fall Quarter 2013 as follows:
