Senate Chair	Enrollment is close to target, ad hoc IT Advisory Committee has met four times, and will continue again next quarter, A2E2 committee members have been selected, mentioned CSUEB magazine feature on Professor Linda Ivey, announced retirement gathering for Susan Correia on 12/8/11
President	Mentioned that the strike on 11/17/11 was conducted with civility, respect and collegiality, absence reporting will take place at the departmental level, discussion of budget reductions and the need for the public to contact legislators, invited all to reception at New UU following meeting
Provost	Discussed commitment to tenure track hires, 20 faculty searches, high quality hires are key
Statewide Academic Senator	Senator Woods reported that the budget for the statewide Academic Senate has been reduced dramatically, disproportionately from other offices, which might indicate the level of regard for shared governance and a means to limit shared governance; funding issues might limit future meeting schedule, some senators are considering resigning in protest
Student Government	ASI President Prado stated that the latest 9% tuition increase is unacceptable
