Reports

Senate Chair	Chair Mahoney announced the investiture of President Morishita scheduled for October 12, 2012, along with faculty honors; Al Fresco will be held the same day; enrollment is on target for the college year; Chris Brown will be leaving the university on May 1, 2012; the Bookstore/Foundation will be renamed but will solicit input from the academic side before finalizing the name change; State University Grants will be awarded to graduate students for the 2012-13 academic year, but the Chancellor's Office is conducting a review of SUGs.
Statewide Academic Senators	Senator Woods announced the ASCSU Chair Jim Postma has completed a second term and there will be an election for a new statewide chair.
CFA	President Eagan announced that the strike vote was underway; the CFA and the CSU have returned to the bargaining table, perhaps due to political pressure from State of California administration
Student Government	ASI President Prado discussed the California Higher Education Student Summit (CHESS) conference and a successful day of lobbying in Sacramento
