**SUBJECT:** 18-19 FUFM 1: Resolution Regarding AS-3348-18/EX: Adoption of “Tenets of System Level Governance in the California State University”

**PURPOSE:** Action by the Academic Senate

**ACTION REQUESTED:**

That the Academic Senate of California State University, East Bay adopt the attached resolution.

**Resolution Regarding AS-3348-18/EX: Adoption of “Tenets of System Level Governance in the California State University”**

WHEREAS, On May 8, 2018, a document entitled “Tenets of System Level Shared Governance in the California State University” (the [Tenets document](#)) was agreed to by the Executive Committee of the Academic Senate of the California State University (ASCSU) and representatives of the Chancellor’s Office; and

WHEREAS, On May 11, 2018, [AS-3334-18/Floor](#): Appreciation for Conversations on System Level Shared Governance in the CSU was adopted by the ASCSU; and

WHEREAS, On September 7, 2018, the ASCSU [discussed](#) the Tenets document; and

WHEREAS, On October 4, 2018, the CSU Sacramento Faculty Senate [endorsed](#) the Tenets document; and

WHEREAS, On October 24, 2018, the CSU Dominguez Hills Academic Senate [rejected](#) the Tenets document; and

WHEREAS, On October 30, 2018, the CSU Stanislaus Academic Senate [opposed](#) the Tenets document; and

WHEREAS, On November 9, 2018, [AS-3348-18/EX](#): Adoption of “Tenets of System Level Governance in the California State University” received a first reading at ASCSU; and

WHEREAS, AS-3348-18/EX will receive a second reading at the ASCSU plenary January 17-18, 2019; and

WHEREAS, In the last academic year, the CSU East Bay Academic Senate championed principles of shared governance in adopting [17-18 BEC 6 amended](#): Resolution Regarding Executive Orders 1100 (revised) and 1110 and [17-18 BEC 10](#): Resolution Regarding Appreciation for the American Association of University Professors’ (AAUP) Support of Shared Governance at the California State University (CSU); therefore be it

RESOLVED that the CSU East Bay Academic Senate objects to the provision for “expedited consultation” in the Tenets document and its implications overriding the intent of the document with respect to shared governance; and be it further

RESOLVED that the CSU East Bay Academic Senate objects to the process by which the Tenets document has been brought forward for adoption, including its being presented for an up-or-down vote; and be it further

RESOLVED that the CSU East Bay Academic Senate reaffirms the principles of shared governance in the Higher Education Employer-Employee Relations Act ([HEERA](#)) and the AAUP [Statement](#) on Government of Colleges and Universities; and be it further

RESOLVED that the CSU East Bay Academic Senate opposes AS-3348-18/EX: Adoption of “Tenets of System Level Governance in the California State University”; and be it further

RESOLVED that this resolution be distributed to the Chancellor, Board of Trustees, Academic Senate of the California State University, Chairs of the other Campus Senates, and the California Faculty Association.
