

STEPS TO CREATE A WEB PAGE ON HAYWIRE

ALL THE COMMANDS ARE IN LOWER CASE AND SHOULD BE TYPED AT THE HAYWIRE PROMPT. PRESS ENTER AFTER EACH LINE.

Note: Whenever you see loginid below, substitute your own login id.

eg: for user named Joe Blow
chmod 705 ~loginid
would become: chmod 705 ~jblow

```

Go ahead and save it by pressing: *ctrl-x, y, enter*

```
haywire(7)% chmod 704 *.*
```
