

# SCHOLARSHIPS TIMELINE

Please keep the following general timeline in mind when applying for scholarships. Each scholarship program varies, so be sure to refer to our website for specific details.

### **DECEMBER**

Scholarship information released at **siliconvalleycf.org/scholarships20**. Make sure to complete and submit the financial aid application that applies to you:

Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at fafsa.ed.gov or California Dream Act Application at dream.csac.ca.gov.

Most scholarships require the completion of one of these two applications to be considered for a scholarship. Read each scholarship's application requirements for details.

### JANUARY-FEBRUARY

Application period opens for most scholarships. Refer to each scholarship's description, contact person or webpage for application instructions and deadlines.

# MARCH-APRIL

Invitations to interview will be emailed to finalists. Please ensure the scholarship program to which you've applied has your correct contact information.

# How do I apply?

Go to siliconvalleycf.org/ scholarships20 to find application instructions.

While program requirements vary, in general, most scholarships require:

- A completed application
- Personal statement
- Transcripts of grades
- Letters of recommendation
- A copy of your current Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), or Student Aid Report (SAR) or California Dream Act Application

**NOTE:** Some scholarships require additional materials (e.g., writing samples, SAT/ACT scores, etc.), so be sure to review each scholarship's application requirements at **siliconvalleycf.org/scholarships20**.

# MID-APRIL/EARLY MAY

Finalists are identified and interviews are conducted (for select programs only).

# **MAY-JUNE**

Student notifications are sent. Notifications are emailed, so please ensure the scholarship program to which you've applied has your correct contact information. Should you be selected as a recipient, you will receive correspondence detailing your award information and requirements for claiming your scholarship.

### **JULY-OCTOBER**

Scholarship payments are disbursed to schools.




Vanessa is the recipient of The Abby Sobrato Scholarship and is studying Biology with aspirations to become an OBGYN.
