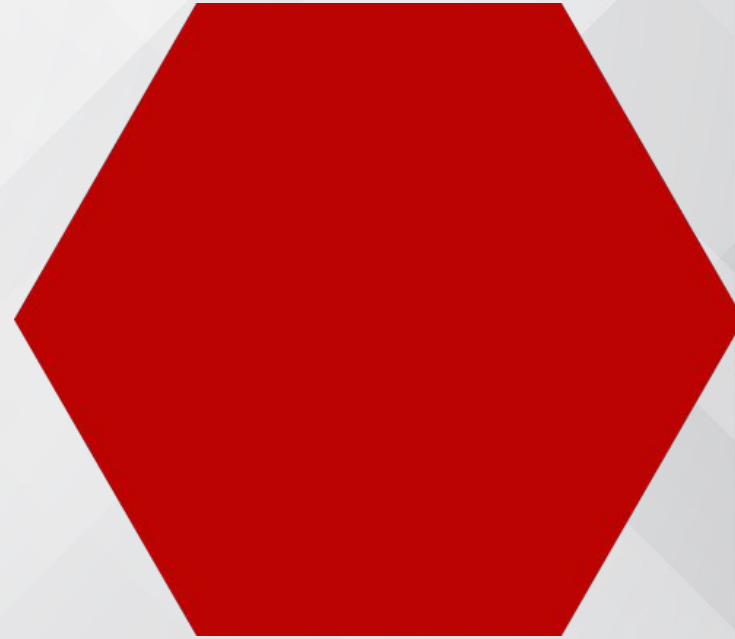

Incoming Students

First-time Freshmen

Undeclared Interest in Nursing students are assigned to a freshman advisor who will help them enroll into the nursing program prerequisites and lower division GE courses during their freshman and sophomore years.

Transfer Students

The nursing department admissions team reviews applications and makes admission decisions. New admitted students will participate in a mandatory orientation during summer break before their first semester begins. Each will be assigned to an academic advisor and a Faculty advisor.



CAMPAIGNS



New Students

Once all transfer credit has been added to the students' records, the academic advisor reviews the DAR and transfer credit. A summary of the remaining GE requirements is sent to the student



Graduating Seniors

Academic advisor reviews the DAR of students who have filed for graduation and notifies students of their remaining requirements. If the registrar requires a signed major check, department staff will create a major check sheet for signature from the academic/GE advisor and the student's faculty advisor. Once signed, the major check is sent to the graduation evaluator.



Re-enrollment

Admissions coordinator will review and may consult with the department chair or program coordinator as appropriate to determine a plan for the student's return.



Targeted Populations

Students struggling with content or concepts should consult with the instructor or their faculty advisor.
