The course is an integrative capstone experience in which students learn to conduct a strategic situational analysis, identify strategic alternatives and write an implementation plan for a strategic initiative. Real world organizational opportunities relating to globalization, innovation and sustainability are emphasized. This course requires students to work in group projects.

Methods & Procedures:

Students worked together and prepared a presentation in the form of a 'Stockholder Debriefing' of their company from the Capsim simulation integrated into their course.

Performance Targets:

There are two targets set for this skill, (1) 75% of students will meet or exceed expectations; and (2) less than 10% of students will score "1" (below expectations) on any "trait" in the rubric. Overall, 77% of students met expectations on the learning objective.


