General Education: Complete 34 semester units of general education (Areas 1 through 6). The units will be counted only once toward the degree. Courses may be used to satisfy both a general education and major requirements. Courses listed in more than one GE area can fulfill only one GE area. All courses in GE must be completed with a "C" or better. It is advisable to complete all 34 units of lower division general education before transfer and to have your GE fully certified. There are no partial GE certifications. Some AP and IB scores may be used for Cal-GETC; CLEP scores may not be used. See an academic counselor.					
Major: All courses in the major emphasis must be completed with a "C" or better. A.A. degrees in a specific discipline require a minimum of 18 units in the major. A.S. degrees in a specific discipline require a minimum of 18 units in the major. A.S. degrees in Astronomy, Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Engineering, Geology, Math, and Physics require a minimum of 30 units in the major.

Please check the dates and deadline calendar on the Admissions & Records website. Transfer Applications for CSU and UC are typically open October through November for Fall admission. Assistance with transfer applications is available at the Transfer Center.
