The California General Education Transfer Curriculum (Cal-GETC) is a series of courses that California complete to satisfy the lower-division breadth/general education requirements before transferring to the University of California (UC). CCC can certify completion of Cal-GETC, which is accepted by all tall UC campuses. A course can only be certified if it was approved for Cal-GETC when it was take for academic year 2025-2026. For a complete listing of courses, their approval dates, and any transfer courses must be completed with grades of "C" or better OR with a "Pass" if the course was taken on a Fis equal to a C grade or higher. Many colleges and universities require letter grades for major course P/NP grades. Students are advised to consult with a counselor/academic adviser before selecting the adviser about UC majors, colleges, and professional schools which do not accept Cal-GETC, and enrolling in final course requirements and receiving conditional admission to the university, students to the De Anza College Admissions and Records Office. - For US-2/US-3: Select one course: POLS C1000, C1000H

Courses taken to satisfy this requirement may also be used to satisfy Cal-GETC **Area 3** and/or **Area 4** at the discretion of the receiving campus; check with the Admissions Office at the receiving CSU campus to confirm double-counting allowance.

## **UC GRADUATION REQUIREMENT: Language Other Than English (LOTE)**
