Completion of Cal-GETC will permit a student to transfer from a California Community College to a California State University or a University of California campus or program generally without the need, after transfer, to take additional lower-division, general education courses to satisfy campus general education requirements. Although it is strongly recommended to complete Cal-GETC prior to transfer, completion of Cal-GETC may not be appropriate for some engineering, math, science, or other high unit majors. A course must have a minimum unit value of 3 semester units to meet the requirements for Cal-GETC. A minimum “C” grade is required in each college course for Cal-GETC. A “C” is defined as a minimum of 2.0 grade points on a 4.0 scale. Please see a counselor for details.

Cal-GETC Certification - Informs colleges that you have completed your lower-division GE requirements and will be posted to your transcript. If receiving an Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT) and transferring to a California State University (CSU), there is no need to get your Cal-GETC certified as GE completion is required to earn the ADT degree and will be posted automatically to your FLC transcript. Apply for Cal-GETC Certification by making an appointment with a counselor (you will need to provide the mailing address of the college you want the certification sent to). **Late May or early June** is a good time to see a counselor for certification.

The UC Language other than English (LOTE) graduation requirement is not part of the Cal-GETC but most non-language undergraduate majors require or recommend students demonstrate competency in at least one Language other than English. Students transferring to a UC will need to pay attention to their transfer college AND major to determine what other than English requirement is and how it can be met.
