## California General Education Transfer Curriculum (Cal-GETC) 2025–2026 ADVISING FORM

ALL CAL-GETC COURSES MUST BE COMPLETED WITH A GRADE OF "A," "B," "C," OR "PASS." FOR "P" GRADES, STUDENTS ARE ALLOWED A LIMITED NUMBER OF UNITS—PREFERABLY NOT IN CAL-GETC AREAS 1 AND 2 AND CERTAINLY NOT FOR MAJOR PREPARATION COURSES.

IVC and CSU students who maintained continuous enrollment before Fall 2025 may continue following the CSU GE or IGETC pattern or choose to complete Cal-GETC, though it is not required. However, new students starting in Fall 2025, as well as students from UC, in-state private institutions, or out-of-state institutions, must complete Cal-GETC.
