

Cal-GETC (2025-26)



The California General Education Transfer Curriculum (Cal-GETC) is a general education pathway for California Community College (CCC) students to fulfill lower-division general education requirements necessary for transfer and admission to both the California State University (CSU) and the University of California (UC).

A minimum "C" grade is required in each area. "Credit/Pas	" grades may be used if they a	are equivalent to a "C" grade (2.0) or better.

Cal-GETC (2025-26)

Students may receive a Lower-Division certification for Cal-GETC, allowing them to make progress towards Upper-Division requirements at a **UC** or **CSU**. Note that not all majors recommend or prioritize the completion of Cal-GETC, particularly STEM majors for UC bound students (https://admission.universityofcalifornia.edu/counselors/preparing-transfer-students/general-education-and-igetc.html). STEM programs require extensive major preparation, which is the focus of UC admission. Students will complete at least 60 transferable units to transfer as Upper-Division. The 60 units may consist of the following:

34 Lower Division Cal-GETC (with a "C" or better)

- + 26 Major Preparation/Electives
 - 60 Minimum Transferable Units for Upper Division Admission
