

California General Education Transfer Curriculum (Cal-GETC) 2025-2026

Completion of this pattern satisfies the 34 units of lower-division general education requirements for transfer to any CSU or UC campus as well as the general education requirements for the Associate Degree for Transfer (AA-T, AS-T) and for the associate degree (AA, AS, AS-UCT). Courses listed in more than one area may be used to satisfy only one area. The course requirements for all areas must be completed before Cal-GETC can be certified. All courses must be completed with grades of 'C' or better (a grade of 'C-' is not acceptable); a "C" is defined as a minimum 2.0 grade points on a 4.0 scale. Consult with a counselor regarding your education plan.
