

2025 - 2026 CALIFORNIA GENERAL EDUCATION TRANSFER CURRICULUM (CalGETC)

CalGETC is the singular transfer general education pathway for California Community College (CCC) students to fulfill lower-division general education requirements for transfer admission to the CSU and UC systems. Students pursuing majors that require extensive lower-division preparation may not find completing the CalGETC advantageous. Biology, Engineering and Liberal Studies are examples of these majors.

All courses must be completed with a grade of “C” or higher. A course may meet only one area of CalGETC.

Some requirements may be satisfied with AP exam credit. See a counselor/advisor for more information.
