<p>AREA F: US HISTORY, CONSTITUTION AND AMERICAN IDEALS (This is a CSU graduation requirement and not part of CSU GE certification). This requirement can be completed at CRC by completion of one of the following patterns: A: One course from HIST 310, 311, 320, 321, 331, or 371 paired with POLS 301 OR B: One course from HIST 310 or 320 paired with one course from HIST 311, 314, 321, or POLS 304 NOTE: Courses used to fulfill this requirement may be used to satisfy 6 of the 9 units in Area D.</p>			
<p>Students transferring to CSU Sacramento may fulfill the following CSUS graduation requirements with the listed general education courses taken at Cosumnes River College:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • English 20 requirement may be fulfilled through completion of either ENGWR 301 or ENGWR 302 (Exempt if ADT is completed) • Race and Ethnicity graduation requirement may be fulfilled through completion of one of the following: COMM 325, ENGLT 336, PSYC 368, or SOC 321 • Foreign language graduation requirement may be fulfilled through completion of any second semester foreign language course at college level (e.g., SPAN 402), or by completion of three years of the same foreign language in high school w/ grades of "C" or better.
