FOREIGN LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY - (May be double-counted in the CSU GE-B): May be met by any one of the following:

- 1. Completion of the third year of a foreign language in high school (grade of "C-" or better)
- 2. Graduation from a secondary school where the language of instruction was not English
- 3. Advanced Placement Foreign Language Examination scores of 3, 4, or 5; or
- 4. Completion of two semesters of a foreign language at a community college or university, with a grade of "C-" or better. Proficiency must be demonstrated at a level comparable to second semester (1B level) of college level (i.e. Spanish 2 at Yuba CC.)

Exempt Majors:

- o If you have declared any of the following majors, then you are EXEMPT from the Foreign Language Graduation Requirement:
 - o Business Administration all concentrations
 - Computer Science all concentrations
 - o Chemistry B.S. only
 - Engineering all concentrations
 - Health Sciences all concentrations
 - o Kinesiology Ex Sci only
 - Nursing all concentrations
 - Physics B.S. only
 - Recreation, Parks, Tourism Administration
