



# California State University (CSU) General Education

## 2022-2023

### TRANSFER ADMISSION ELIGIBILITY:

A transfer student will be required to complete **60 semester/90 quarter CSU transferable units** including a minimum of 30 semester/45 quarter units in General Education (GE) courses with a minimum GPA of 2.0; this includes completion of Areas A1, A2, A3, and B4 (the "Golden 4") with a grade of **C-** or higher in each course (nine units from English composition, oral communications, critical thinking and three units from quantitative reasoning).

### CERTIFICATION REQUESTS:

A student planning to transfer to the California State University system should request to have their GE units certified by Compton College (CC) by submitting a [Request for Certification](#) to the [Admissions and Records Office](#), during their last semester of attendance at CC.

Certification is important as students who transfer without certification will be held responsible for the transfer institution's general education pattern which could result in completing additional courses. Students meeting the requirements for Full Certification will have met the necessary requirements completing all lower division general education for the California State Universities; 9 additional GE Upper Division semester units will be required after transfer. Students who have completed courses at other regionally accredited colleges are advised to see a counselor. Transcripts from other regionally accredited universities and colleges need to be on file at CC. Foreign coursework not from a US-regionally accredited institution may not be used for certification on the CSU breadth requirements. **Note: certification must be submitted to the university by the last community college attended.**

Additionally, students completing the CSU GE certification are also eligible to receive a CSU GE Certificate of Achievement from CC; see a counselor for more details.
