<b>CSU Graduation Requirement: U.S. History, Constitution, and American Ideals</b> - not part of CSU GE Breadth, but may be completed prior to transfer. 8 quarter units. Complete US-1, US-2, and US-3. <b>For US-1</b> select one course: AFAM 12A, 12B, HIST 17A, 17AH, 17B, 17BH, 17C, 17CH, 18A, 18B <b>For US-2 &amp; US-3</b> select one course: POLI 1, 1H Courses taken to satisfy this requirement may also be used to satisfy CSU GE-Breadth subject area requirements at the discretion of the receiving campus; check with Admissions at the receiving CSU campus to confirm double-counting allowance.			
<b>CSU GE Breadth for STEM</b> - Students earning an Associate Degree for Transfer in a high-unit STEM major may be eligible to complete CSU GE Breadth for STEM, deferring two lower-division GE courses until after transfer. At De Anza College, the Biology AS-T allows CSU GE Breadth for STEM. CSU GE Breadth for STEM certification as part of the Biology AS-T requires completion of: a. All courses in Areas A, B, E, and F; and b. One course in Area C1 (Arts); one course in Area C2 (Humanities); and one course in Area D. Consult with a counselor or academic adviser to discuss which general education pattern is the best option for you.
