- Areas A1, A2, A3, and B4 must be completed with a “C-” or better.
- Area D: Continuing students (entering before Fall 2021) that maintain continuous enrollment (or catalog rights) are not required to complete Area F. However, continuing students will need to complete 9 semester (or 12 quarter) units from Area D (from at least two different disciplines) for full GE certification and transfer degrees. Please see a counselor for more information.
- Area F: New students entering Fall 2021 and thereafter will be required to complete this area for full GE certification and transfer degrees. Please see a counselor for more information.
- For CSU admission, 30 units of general education courses must be completed with grades of “C” or better.
- Courses may be used to fulfill only one General Education area.
- Courses used to fulfill General Education may double count with courses used to fulfill a major requirement.
- Courses on this list are approved for the academic year 2023-2024, which is valid beginning Fall 2023 through Summer 2024.
- Students wishing to use a course to meet a CSU general education requirement must be sure that the course is approved for the academic year in which it is taken.

- Each CSU campus will have additional graduation requirements outside the lower division CSU GE-B.
- A General Education (GE) Certification is an official document from the College of the Sequoias that certifies a student completing lower division general education breadth.
- Certification is not automatic - students must request certification. Students may request certification after acceptance to a CSU/UC.
 - Official transcripts from all other accredited institutions attended must be on file and will be reviewed for inclusion in the certification process.
 - A minimum of 39 semester units is required for a complete certification.
 - All official transcripts including college, high school, AP, and IB test scores are required.
- Confirm with a COS Counselor if you meet transfer admission eligibility

NOTE: This pattern is designed to satisfy the lower division General Education (GE) requirement for any CSU campus. A course with a grade of “P” or “CR” may be used if the grading policy of the community college where the course was taken states that the “P” or “CR” grade is equivalent to a “C” grade or better. Courses must be on the CSU GE-B when the course was taken. Courses taken in person or online at other community colleges will be applied to CSU GE-B according to how they were approved at the college and the semester where completed. Courses listed courses in multiple areas may only be used once, except for US History, Constitution, and American Ideals courses.
