Foothill College will certify completion of 58 quarter units of the 70 -unit General Education requirement for graduation from the CSU for students satisfying courses from the following pattern. The remaining 12 quarter units must be taken in the upper division of the degreegranting CSU campus. A minimum of 45 units in GE including all of Areas A and B4 with grades of C or better in each course must be completed prior to transfer. Students must request certification upon transferring. Courses listed in two areas may be only applied to one.
