



2023 - 2024 CSU General Education Breadth Requirements

Upon completion of the full pattern of courses listed below, Skyline College will certify that a student's lower division general education requirements have been completed for any of the 23 campuses within the CSU system (partial certification also available). Certification is not automatic. You may request certification with your final transcript online via Websmart. For further information, please consult a Skyline College counselor or the Skyline College Admissions and Records Office.

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR TRANSFER AS A JUNIOR TO A CSU CAMPUS, YOU MUST:

- Complete at least 60 CSU transferable units with a "C" average (2.0)
- Complete at least 30 of the 39 units from the GE courses listed below, including one course from each of the following areas: **A1**, **A2**, **A3**, and **B4** with grades of "C-" or higher. Please be aware that for some campuses and majors, you may not complete Areas A1, A2, A3, and B4 during your last term prior to enrolling at a CSU campus. Please see counselor for specifics.
- While a course may be listed in more than one area, it may be used to satisfy only ONE subject requirement.

Although not a transfer or CSU admissions requirement, the CSU system requires students to complete coursework in American History (US-1), The U.S. Constitution (US-2), California State & Local Government (US-3) as a graduation requirement. The following courses may be taken prior to transfer to meet this CSU graduation requirement and may also be applied to meet approved CSU GE Areas.

Note: There are instances when a course is approved for CSU GE, IGETC, and/or AH&I at Skyline College but the same course at College of San Mateo or Canada College is not approved to meet that same area. Please check if the course that you plan on registering for is approved for the same GE or AHI Area at CSM or Cañada.
