3. Advanced Placement Foreign Language Examination scores of 3,4 , or 5 .
4. Completion of two semesters of a foreign language at a community college or university, with a grade of " C -" or better. Proficiency must be demonstrated at a level comparable to the second semester (1B level) of college level language (i.e. Spanish 2 at Yuba CCD.
