The CSU system allows students to complete lower-division general education requirements by following the pattern below. Students must have a minimum grade of 'C-' in Areas A1, A2, A3, and B4. Students must request **general education certification** from a counselor prior to transferring. *Courses in red are no longer offered at LTCC but still count towards general education requirements.
