

Hello Pioneers,

On January 22-26, 2024, the California Faculty Association (CFA) organized a CSU systemwide strike in coalition with Teamsters Local 2010 members as a response to no compromises made between CFA and CSU management. CFA calls for raising the base salary for the lowest-paid and struggling faculty, manageable workloads for more student engagement, more mental health services for students, limits to police power, and humane/adequate parental leave for a better educational environment. Supporting faculty for better working conditions is something that California State University, East Bay ASI will continue to support. ASI will continue to support the Jan 22-26 CFA strike for CFA and CSU management to settle for a fair contract.

ASI encourages CSUEB students to support faculty in a multitude of ways leading to the strike. Since campus will remain open on January 22-26, we encourage you to ask your professors about the strike and support the faculty who are participating. In addition, if any forms are being sent in regards to faculty participation, we ask that you DO NOT report faculty that are going on strike. We would also like to recognize that some professors may not be in communication on all platforms from January 22-26 due to being on strike. Some professors will also accommodate the workload but we recommend that you check in with your professors on how classwork may be affected. CSUEB ASI also urges students to participate in CFA-led activities leading up to the strike as seen on the flier. As the ASI Board of Directors are recommended to join CFA at the picket lines, we also recommend the students to join us. We also understand that students can choose to not participate in the strikes or to choose an entrance that does not have a picket line. Since teachers, counselors, and librarians may strike, there may be a delay on student services and possible traffic on CSUEB entrances. Let's work together to bring CFA and CSU Management toward a fair contract!
