

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Advancing STEM Pioneers in Research on Energy Sciences (ASPIRES) Program is a 10-week **PAID** summer internship that aims to provide 10 **CSUEB undergraduate students** exposure to the vast scientific network at Berkeley Lab and shine a light on many possible career paths with a STEM degree.

Students will be matched with a project and mentor from Berkeley Lab's <u>Energy Sciences</u> <u>Area</u> staff.

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a US citizen or Permanent US Resident
- Must be an undergraduate at CSUEB
- Must be pursuing a Bachelor's degree in: Biology, Chemistry/Biochemistry, Computer Science, Earth & Environmental Sciences, Engineering, Math, Physics, or Statistics/Biostatistics
- Upper division coursework preferred, but not required
- NO GPA MINIMUM
- NO LAB EXPERIENCE REQUIRED
- Students of <u>all backgrounds</u> are encouraged to apply!
