The BS in Business Administration with HRM/OB concentration can be completed in four years, but to do so requires careful planning and preparation. A student's cumulative GPA, CSUEB-only GPA, and major GPA must be at a minimum of 2.00 in order to graduate.

Important Footnotes	
1) Prerequisite may be met with a score of 63 on the Math Proficiency Assessment (MPA) . For more information, visit the CSUEB Testing Office. If met with MPA, take MATH 180. Free elective may be needed.	
2) MATH 180 can be substituted with MATH 130. MATH 130 has prerequisites of MATH 115 and MATH 120.	
3) To avoid taking additional units, it is recommended that Overlay requirements are met within your GE or major.	
4) To avoid taking additional units, consider taking a class combined with a lab to fulfill B3 if not already satisfied.	
5) Students must select HRM Electives for which they have completed the prerequisites. Refer to catalog or MyCSUEB for details.	
6) May require additional courses to meet the 120 units required for graduation. These courses are free electives which can be taken outside of GE and major.	
7) Prerequisites are strictly enforced. Permission numbers may be needed if course was completed outside of CSUEB. To request permission numbers, submit the Undergraduate Permission Number Request Form online at: www.csueastbay.edu/cbeugforms .
