


Bachelor's Degree Requirements

The following chart summarizes the components of Bachelor's degrees in CLASS.




Finding Your Degree Requirements

All university and academic program requirements are listed in the general catalog, which is updated on yearly basis. Typically, it will default to the most current year to reflect updated policies and regulations. However, for the purpose of tracking your university, general education, and major requirements students may need to access an archived version that applies to their situation—that is, the year they began their academic career and/or declared their major of preference. You may access the university general catalog by completing the following steps:

- 1) Access the [general catalog](#)
- 2) Select relevant catalog year (in the example, 2019-2020)
- 3) Use the search box to find your major (in the example, criminal justice)
- 4) Alternatively, you may also find your major by college, department, or degree type
- 5) To review undergraduate degree requirements, you may navigate to undergraduate information and select “Requirements, Exams, and Testing”



Tracking Your Progress towards Degree

One of the most convenient ways for students to track their progress toward degree is to regularly access and consult their degree audit report (DAR). Your personalized DAR is an official record based on the requirements of the general catalog for the year during which you began your academic career. You may access your DAR by completing the following steps:

- 1) Login into [MyCSUEB](#)
- 2) Proceed to Student Center
- 3) Under the "Academics" tab select Degree Audit Report (DAR) and proceed
- 4) Your DAR will reflect the declared major, graduation status, and academic standing
- 5) Scroll through the entire DAR to determine the requirements you have already completed and those to be taken in the future terms (your advisor will be able to assist you with this step, if needed)
