- EPSY 500 (4) *Educating all Students in Diverse Classrooms* (Required for Speech-Language-Hearing Services Credential in CA)

1. To reach "Classified" status, this content or its equivalent must be completed: *Speech and Hearing Science, Audiological Assessment, Physical Science Requirement (met by a Physics/Chemistry course that meets ASHA standards)*
2. Prior to starting the graduate course sequence laid out below, all students must have completed **25 hours of clinical observation**.
3. Graduate students are expected to enroll in one summer term in Year 1 or Year 2 of graduate study.

NOTES

1. Content on Literacy and School-based Issues – Will be infused throughout the curriculum with discernible evidence in course syllabi, weekly topic schedules, and X number of signature assignments in specific courses.
2. Graduate students will be required to register in SPPA 608 two times on two distinct topics, to fulfill their 4 elective units.
3. Topic List Suggested: Traumatic Brain Injury, Dementia, Head & Neck Cancer, Cleft Palate, Early Intervention, Autism
Caveat – Choosing this route as opposed to pre-decided selected courses (e.g. SPPA 6225: Dementia; SPPA 6223: Early Intervention)
4. PRACTICUM UNITS: Require 5 units of SPPA 695 (Therapy), 2 units of SPPA 696 (Diagnostics-this will include hearing screenings) and two 6-unit internships (SPPA 698).
5. EPSY 500 is a State of CA requirement for being credentialed and receiving the Speech-Language Hearing Svcs Credential
6. SPPA 699: Department Thesis –OPTIONAL (See separate proposal for Department Thesis Eligibility and Requirements). Students completing a department thesis do not take the Masters Comprehensive Examination.
