



Off-Campus CPR Training

Candidates applying for a Preliminary Multiple Subject or Single Subject Teaching Credential, Clear Education Specialist Instruction, or Clear (Ryan) Multiple/Single Subject Teaching Credentials are required to complete Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) training in infant, child, and adult CPR. The training must meet the standards of the American Heart Association or American Red Cross and be valid at the time of the credential application. Please refer to your credential instruction sheet to confirm if CPR is required for your credential.
