- Prospective students: Email ALL unofficial transcripts, foreign transcript evaluation if applicable, passing test score report if applicable, a copy of your \$25 [CashNet Department Application fee](#) receipt and this completed form to **credentials@csueastbay.edu**. The subject line of your email should be **Request for BSR Evaluation-program name, application term, last name**.
- Enrolled students: Email ALL unofficial transcripts, foreign transcript evaluation if applicable, passing test score report if applicable, evidence of enrollment in a Credential program (unofficial CSU East Bay transcript), and this completed form to **credentials@csueastbay.edu**. The subject line of your email should be **Request for BSR Evaluation-program name, start term, last name**.
- This form will only be reviewed if the request is complete with required attachments, including, but not limited to all transcripts, test score reports, and [Department Application fee](#) receipt, or evidence of enrollment in a CSU East Bay Credential program.
- The results of the BSR evaluation will be emailed to you in up to 4-6 weeks.
- Incomplete BSR evaluation forms and/or requests will be delayed and may be returned for completion, more information, and resubmission.
- Courses must be 3-semester or 4-quarter units, have a grade of B- or better, be non-remedial, be taken at a regionally accredited college or university, or community college), and be degree applicable (AA degree applicable is acceptable). Catalog or course descriptions submitted with your request will help with evaluation.
 - *For reading proficiency: a course in critical thinking, literature, philosophy, reading, rhetoric, or textual analysis.
 - *For writing proficiency: a course in composition, English, rhetoric, written communication, or writing. (To use the same course for reading and writing, it needs to say rhetoric or you need to get a letter from the English Department Chair stating that the course covers both the reading and writing areas).
 - *For mathematics proficiency: a course in algebra, geometry, mathematics, quantitative reasoning, or statistics.
