Bachelors Plus Early Pathway to Multiple Subject Teaching Course Units

At California State University, East Bay, the Bachelors Plus Early Pathway to Multiple Subject Teaching (BPEP MS) program leads to a Bachelor of Arts degree in Liberal Studies and a Preliminary Multiple Subject Teaching Credential simultaneously. Verification of completion is denoted by an official transcript with the bachelor's degree posted.

Courses for the teaching credential program are at the post-baccalaureate level; however, some of the units are used toward the total units required for the bachelor's degree. Courses not counted towards the bachelor's degree requirements are denoted as "Grading Basis: Course Excluded from Statistics."

It is up to the employer to determine which courses will be used for salary placement purposes.
