



Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) Participation Agreement Form

The Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE), a program of the Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education (WICHE), allows undergraduate students from participating Western states and U.S. territories to enroll in select four-year college programs at a reduced tuition rate. Cal State East Bay is a WUE member institution and offers eligible full-time students who are residents of WUE states or territories tuition at 150% of the California resident rate. This represents a substantial savings compared to standard non-resident tuition.

WUE Participation Agreement Forms must be submitted 10 business days prior to the fee payment deadline to be reviewed and approved for WUE tuition. Forms received after the deadline will have WUE fees posted starting in the following academic term.

Please review the following information prior to submitting your WUE form:

- WUE students are not eligible for California resident state university fees. Students cannot apply time accrued while participating in the WUE program to establish California residency.
- Students may receive the WUE tuition rate until completion of a bachelor's degree **provided that the following requirements are met:**
 - Enrolled full-time (12 units or more) while in the WUE program and maintain the academic standards required of non-resident students.
 - The major being pursued has to be on-ground or hybrid (fully online majors are not available for this tuition discount program)
 - Maintain your legal state of residence and have a permanent address outside of California
 - Must have a mailing address in California
