- 5. The above plan *does not* include summer courses. If you choose to take courses in the summer then you would complete the major sooner.

Semester Conversion Transitional Course Equivalency Policies for HDEV and WOST Courses

- 1. If you started your HDEV major or WOST minor in or before Spring 2018, and graduate in or after Fall 2018, you may choose to follow either the requirements of the catalog of the term when you declared your major, or the requirements of the catalog of the term of your graduation.
- 2. If you are entitled and chose to follow the 2017-2018 (or earlier) catalog, you may use HDEV 499 (equivalent of 6 quarter units) as a substitute for both HDEV 4811 and HDEV 4812 (totaling 8 quarter units).
- 3. For all other HDEV and WOST courses, except for HDEV 4811, 4812, and HDEV 499 as mentioned above, any quarter-based courses are equivalent to any semester-based course, with the 1 (semester) unit to 1.5 (quarter) units ratio, as long as the course contents are not the same (e.g., if a student has already taken HDEV 3301 Child Development, the student is not allowed to take HDEV 311 Child Development as a substitute for other courses.).
