Housing Furnishings:

-The rates listed above include; a meal plan, all utilities, Wi-Fi, streaming service, and laundry services.

-**Suites Double/Triple** includes two bathrooms, a kitchenette with a dining table, a living room with couches, two armchairs, a coffee table, and an end table. Each bedroom can have up to three twin XL beds, dressers, desks, and chairs.

-**Suites Super Singles** includes two bathrooms, a kitchenette with a dining table, a living room with couches, two armchairs, a coffee table, and an end table. Super Singles will only have one occupant per bedroom. Please note that bedrooms may have additional furniture based on the original occupancy designation as a double room.

-**Apartment Double/Triple/Quad** includes one bathroom, a kitchen with a dining table, a living room with a couch and an armchair, an end table, and coffee table. Each bedroom can have up to four twin XL beds, dressers, desks, and chairs.

-**Apartment Single** includes two bathrooms, a kitchen with a dining table, a living room with a couch and an armchair, an end table, and a coffee table. Each bedroom can have up to one twin XL bed, dresser, desk, and chair.

Meal Plan

A meal plan is mandatory for all residents living in University Housing. Depending on the selected meal plan, residents may eat in the Pioneer Kitchen, Monday through Sunday (breakfast, lunch, and dinner on weekdays; brunch and dinner on weekends), and utilize Flex Dollars at any campus dining location.

Please note the following:

-Housing rent includes a \$22.50 (semester) resident activity contribution used to fund activities and events coordinated by the Residence Hall Association.

-It is the responsibility of the student to adhere to payment due dates. A \$75.00 late fee will be applied to late payments. Late fees will continue to be assessed throughout the delinquency process. It is also the responsibility of the student to adhere to financial aid deadlines (if applicable).
