

# Returning Residence Hall Association Selection Process

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Below is information about the selection process for the Returning Residence Hall Association Executive Board Members. Selection for Returning RHA Executive Board members will be based on both application materials and prior performance.

The deadline to complete all RHA Executive Board application materials is **Sunday, December 18, 2022 at 11:59 pm.**

**Supplemental Application Components:** The following items are part of the application. It is recommended that you take your time to ensure your application materials best reflect your work. We also encourage you to utilize the resources available for getting feedback on materials before submitting.

- 1. One Short Essay Question:** It is recommended that you write these in word or google docs first, then copy and paste them into the application form to allow for easier editing and to ensure information is not lost.

Please share why you are interested in being selected for the position(s) you indicated above. Please include the following in your response:

- Strengths/experience you feel you can bring to the position(s).
- Ideas or goals you have for the position(s).
- How this position(s) can further your own professional development?

- 2. Video Presentation:**

Please submit a video that addresses the following prompts. The video should be no more than 10 minutes in length.

- What have you learned about yourself through the RHA position this year? (strengths you have discovered, challenges you have had to overcome, etc)
- How have you fostered connections among residents?
- How have you contributed towards the goals and successes of the RHA Executive Board this year?
- How will you continue to contribute towards the goals and successes of the RHA Executive Board if rehired?
- How will you continue to foster connections among residents if rehired?

**Format:** Please submit in a file format that can be opened on any PC computer without added software needing to be installed (mp4 preferred). If you are unsure about the format, we recommend uploading your video to YouTube and providing the link on your application. YouTube settings can be changed so that the video is not a public post.

You have creative freedom in how you structure the content of your video. We are not evaluating you based on technical skills. Our focus is on capturing information that addresses the prompts. Thus regardless of how you format your video, you will want to ensure you are staying focused on providing information that addresses all 4 prompts.

Video Brainstorming: For those who may need some ideas on ways to structure your video here are a couple options. These are by no means the only options so again feel free to use your creativity.

- Use the record feature on Zoom to capture yourself giving a presentation. Using the share screen function while recording allows the viewer to see the presentation while you talk.
- Use your phone or other recording device to capture different video clips and edit together with a free app. (Splice, WeVideo, iMovie, Quik, Cameo, etc)
- Have a friend record you giving a presentation on a phone or other recording device.
- Use the presentation template in Canva and download as an MP4. (Add videos, music, etc)
